An introduction to music theory, this course covers key signatures, clefs, time signatures, scales, intervals, chords, notation, and analysis of diatonic chord progressions.

Jam/ Improv Workshop Ensemble

Pre-requisites: Must be familiar with basic chord progressions; major and minor pentatonic scales.

Jazz Ensemble

Explore music through your own creativity. We will dive deeper into jazz improvisation by applying introductory jazz theory to classic jazz songs.
