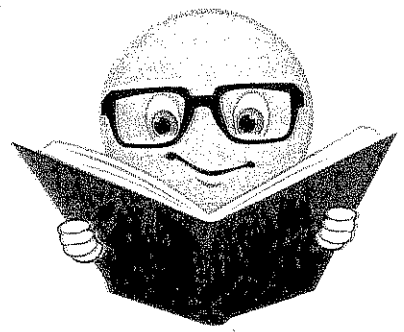


Things Good Readers Do



Preview

- Look at the cover and title.
- Look at some of the pictures and read some of the text.

Question

- Ask who, what, when, where, why, and how.
- Decide if what you've read makes sense.

Predict

- Wonder about what will happen next.
- Make guesses and read ahead to see if your predictions are correct.

Infer

- Imagine the details.
- Use what you've read to understand what the author means.

Connect

- Relate what you've read to what you know, and to your thoughts and feelings.
- Compare what you've read to other texts and to the world around you.

Summarize

- Organize and connect the details.
- Draw your own conclusions.

Evaluate

- Think about what you've read.
- What did you learn?
- Was it important to you? Why? or Why not?
- Did you like it? Why? or Why not?
