Early Childhood Studies II

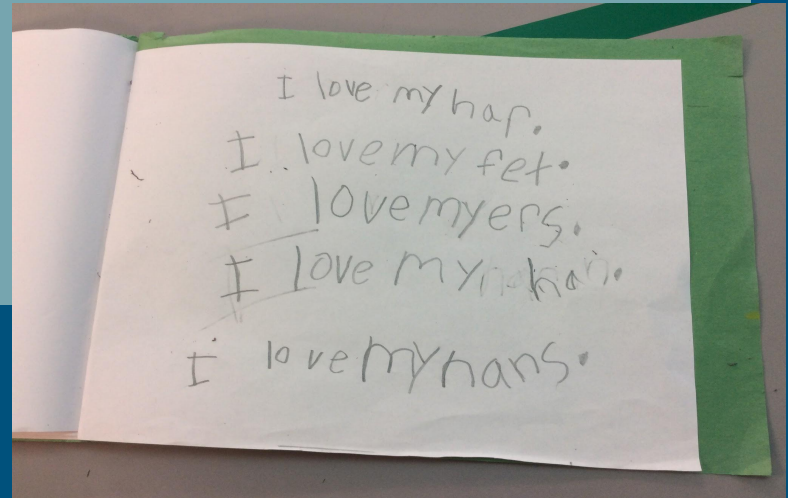


Students observe and plan activities that are implemented in the Preschool classrooms at Westerly High School.
