PICKING APPLES

If you live near apple-growing farms, you can get the very freshest fruit, along with some fresh air and exercise, by going to a pick-your-own orchard. These fruit farms often post signs on roads or run ads in local papers. Call in advance to see if you need to bring baskets and to check on the kinds of apples they grow.

RATING APPLES

Big apples may look solid, but often they are mealy and mushy inside. Small or medium-sized fruit may taste better. Here are some names of apples and their features to help you get the right kind of apple for your needs.

A **Northern Spy** is somewhat tart and is best for baking because it holds its shape well when cooked.

A **Cortland** apple is somewhat tart too, but it has a nice crunch. It is best for salads because it will not discolor as fast as some others.

Red and Golden Delicious apples are good to eat; both kinds are sweet and juicy.
