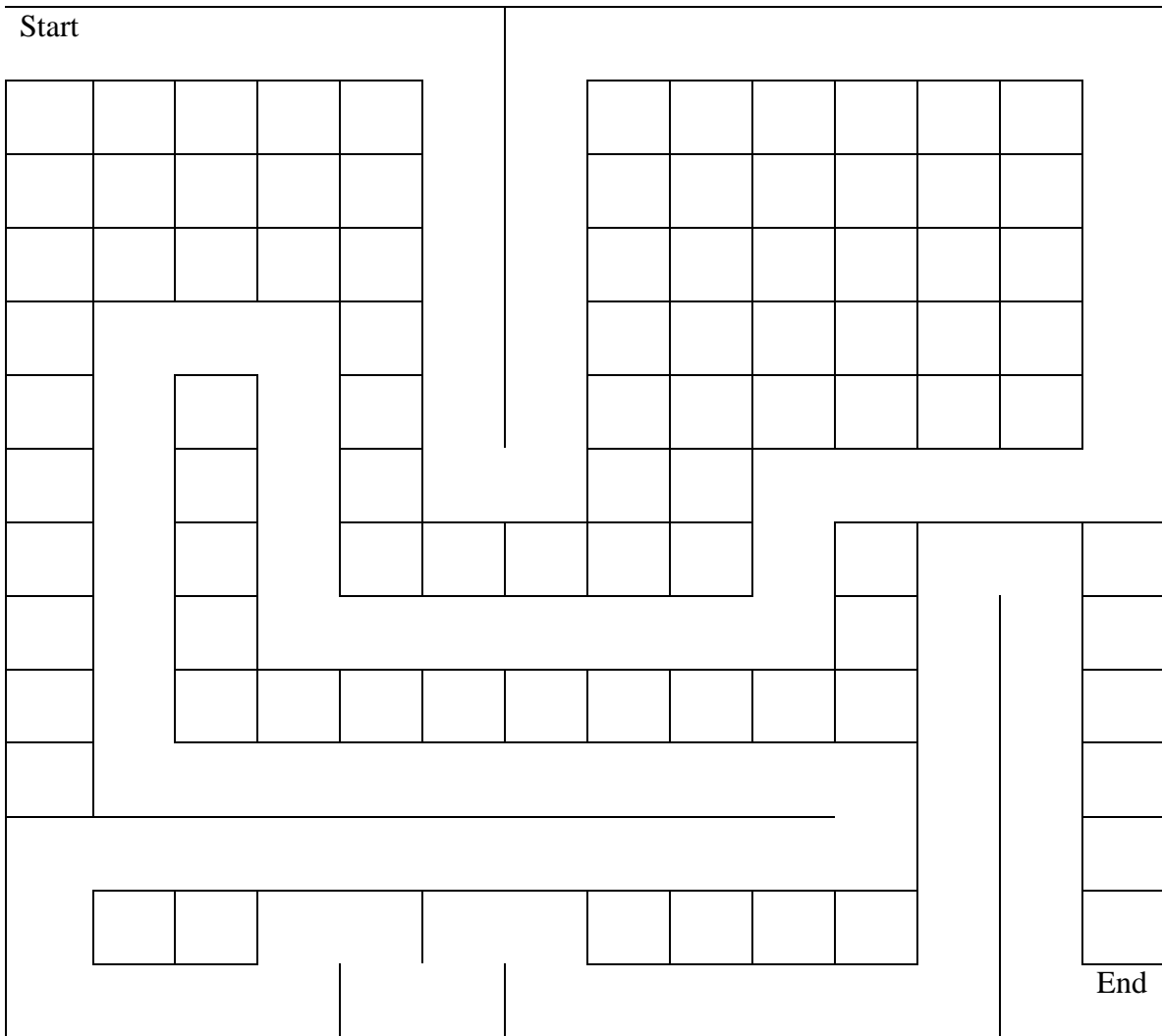
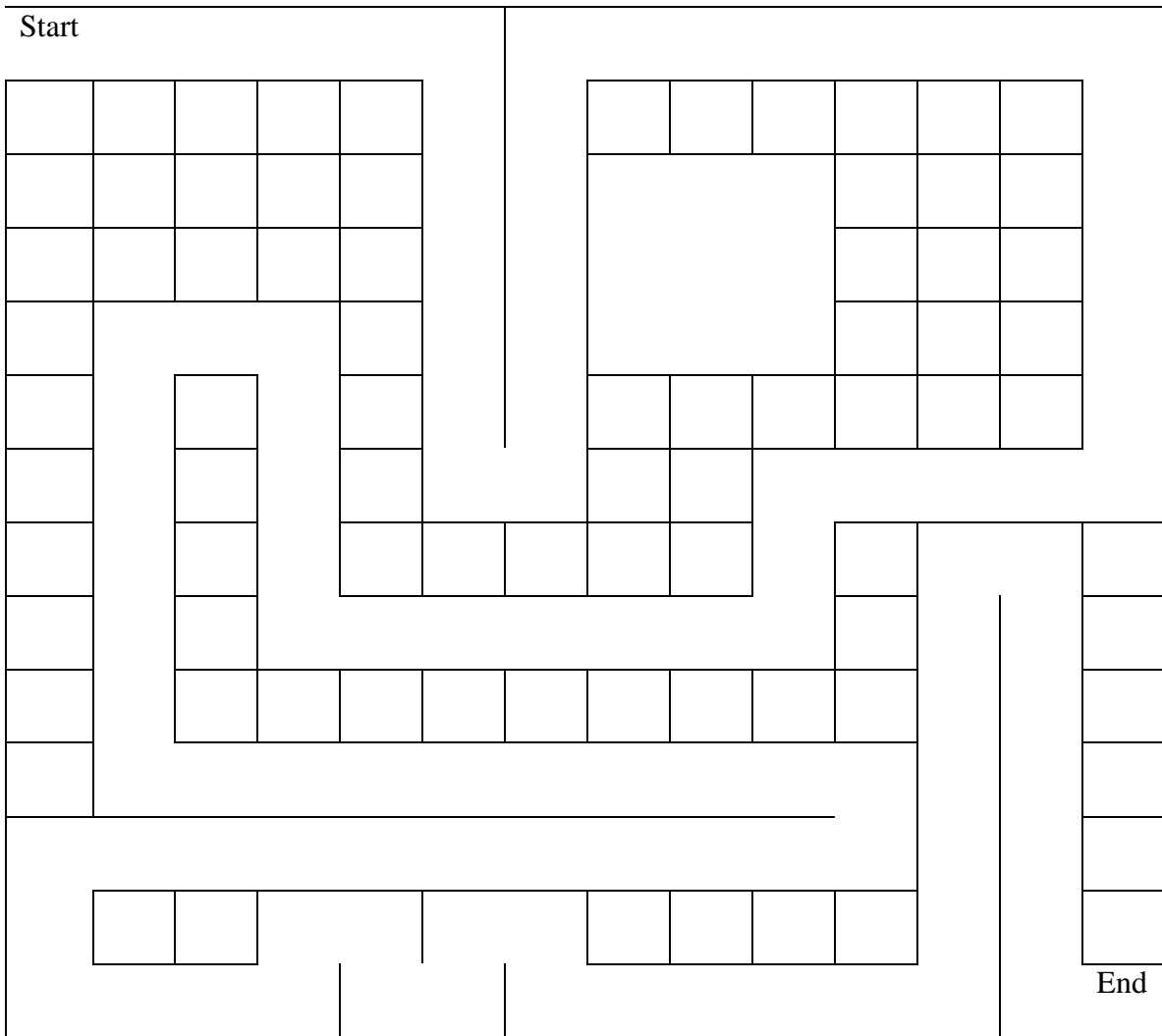




**Step 3** Create a path between a Start and End point using the Border icon on the Formatting Toolbar to remove cell walls.



**Step 4** Choose a place to insert a picture (later Step 5) by highlighting an area of 4 or 9 cells and merge those cells by selecting Table/Merge Cells.



**Step 5a and 5b** Choose a picture from ClipArt and insert it into the space you've created. Ensure your cursor is in the newly merged cell, then select Insert/Picture/ClipArt and insert the picture. The picture may not fit perfectly at first (see below), so be sure to adjust the size and proportion immediately to retain consistency in cell sizes throughout the maze (shown at bottom).

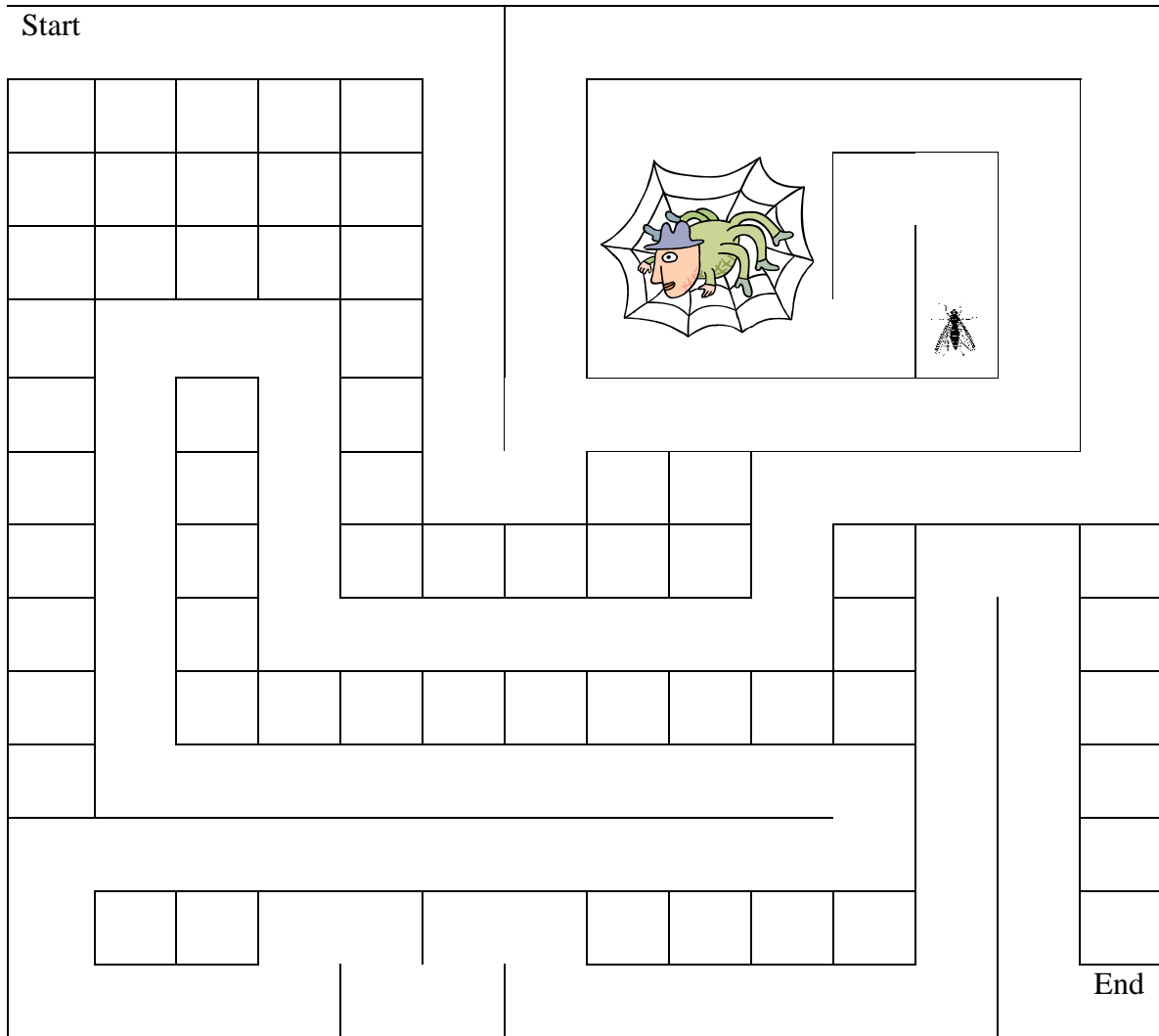

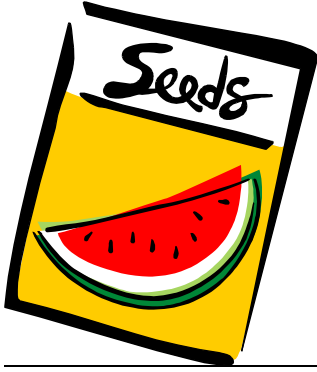

5b) Adjusting the picture size will return the rows and columns to their original width and height

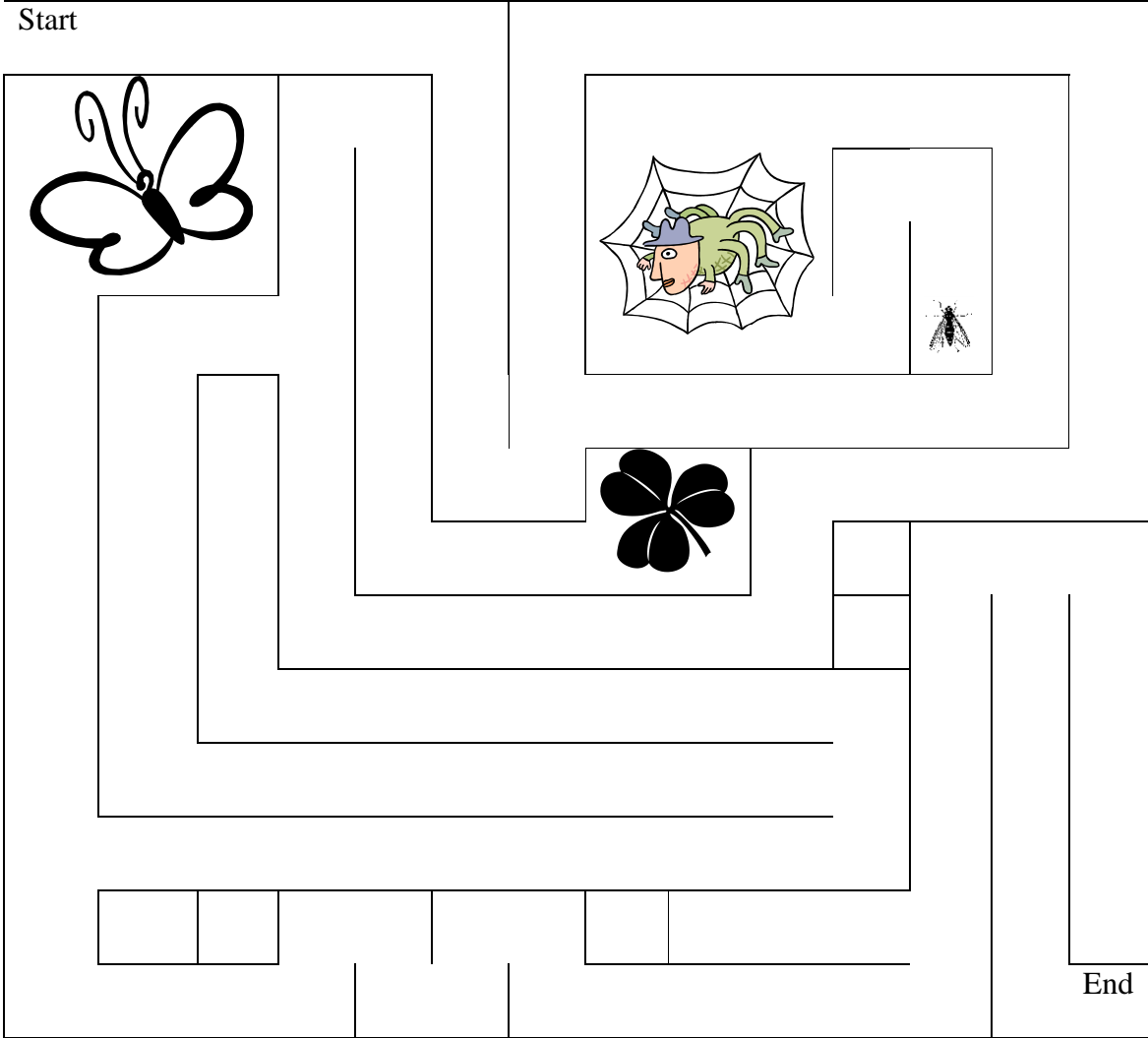
**Step 6** Create additional paths to create dead ends in the picture you created.



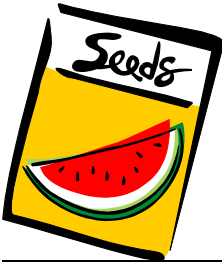
**Step 7** Continue to carefully add paths and pictures, adjusting the details as you go to create a challenging maze for your friends.
