Westerly Public Schools Confidentiality of Student Records

No. 5090

It is a policy of the Westerly School Committee that a record shall be maintained for educational benefit for each student attending the public schools of the Town of Westerly from date of entry to date of exit.

The student's record and such information contained therein shall be open for inspection and review as provided under the provisions of the General Education Provisions Act, as amended.

This policy statement recognizes that collection and maintaining data to assist students in present and future endeavors must be done in a way that will not impinge upon a student's privacy or other rights.
