Policies

Westerly Public Schools School Dances and Functions WMS

No. 7210

Various functions are scheduled during the school year by teams, departments, or organizations. Westerly Middle School evening activities/dances for sixth graders will ordinarily be held from 2:00-4:00 p.m. and for seventh and eighth graders will be held from 7:00-9:00 p.m.

The following policy applies to evening activities, dances, and functions:

- 1. Students are eligible to attend school dances and functions only if they have attended school on that day.
- 2. Students must arrive at school dances no later than ½ hour after the start of the dance and may not leave until the conclusion.
- Students will only be allowed to leave earlier in the event of an illness or an
 emergency with the approval of an administrator and in the company of a
 parent or designated emergency contact. Students who leave any dance or
 activity may not re-enter, and parents will be contacted immediately.
- 4. Students from other schools may not attend dances as the guest of Westerly Middle School students.
- 5. Students under any influence of alcohol or drugs will be removed immediately from the dance and parents and police will be notified.
- 6. The group sponsoring the dance will be responsible for following the policy for a school dance.
- 7. Students must dress and dance appropriately. Fondling, bumping and grinding or anything that connotates sexual innuendo is prohibited.
- 8. Students must purchase tickets and provide signed parent permission, including contact phone number, in advance by the designated deadline. No tickets will be sold at the door.
- 9. Students attending other evening events such as spelling bee, prize speaking, music performance, etc. must be accompanied by an adult.
- 10. Parents/guardians are invited to chaperone evening school functions. They are considered volunteers and must meet all other policy requirements.
- 11. Evening activities are extracurricular. It will therefore remain an administrative decision based upon in-school behaviors prior to any dance/activity to deny any student the opportunity to attend. Student, parents/guardians will be informed when such a decision is necessary.
- 12. All other school rules apply.
